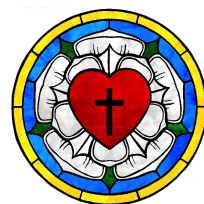
GOD IN FILM

ORGAN PROJECT UPDATE

Preparatory work continues for the addition of two new ranks of pipes to our Taylor & Boody organ. The wall behind the organ is being hardened to improve the sound reflection and insulated to minimize temperature changes. At some point in the coming weeks, there will be times when the organ will not be operational as Taylor & Boody prepares the organ cabinet for the new addition, all of the existing pipes are removed and cleaned, and the new pipes are installed, voiced, and tuned. We will utilize the Klop continuo organ and/or the piano when the Taylor & Boody is not available.
