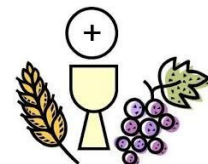
SERMON DISCUSSION GROUP

MIDWEEK HOLY COMMUNION

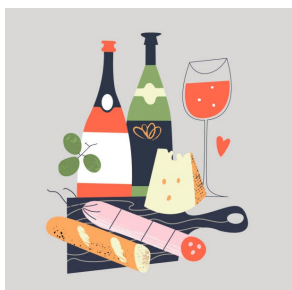
