THE FEAST OF PENTECOST

Sunday, May 19, is the Feast of Pentecost – the fiftieth day of Easter. On this day, we celebrate the Holy Spirit as the power of God among us that heals, forgives, inspires, and unites. The account of the Pentecost story in the book of Acts uses images of wind and fire to describe how the Spirit was poured out on disciples from all nations. Therefore, the liturgical color for the day is red to symbolize the tongues of fire. **Worshippers are invited to wear red** on Pentecost Sunday as we gather for festive worship.

SERMON DISCUSSION GROUP

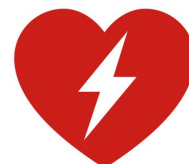
