Thank you so much for your donation to Meals on Wheels of Greater Lynchburg. Your support enables us to continue to meet an ever-growing need and serve some of the most vulnerable individuals in our area.

Since the very beginning of our service, almost 50 years ago, we've known we are having an important positive impact on our homebound neighbors, but now we are gathering data to 'prove it' even further. In a survey last

fall, 88% of recipients surveyed said they feel safer at home knowing that a volunteer from Meals on Wheels will be stopping by each day. Gratitude and relief are expressed in many ways, such as this response from a recent request for service. Sandra said, "You're bringing me to tears. I have been so worried about this surgery and what I was going to do when I got home. Thank you!"
